Minutes for the Extra Ordinary Meeting for the purpose to discuss the Precept for 2017/2018, of Red Lodge Parish Council, held on Tuesday, 29th November, 2016, at the Sports Pavilion, Red Lodge, commencing at 7.00 pm.

#### **Welcome and apologies for absence**

#### **Declarations of Interest and Applications for Dispensation**

#### **Public Questions on any items on the Agenda and opportunity to raise Agenda items for future Meetings.**

A member of the public expressed their concerns in respect of cars parking at the junction of Bellflower Crescent and Warren Road. The Parish Clerk explained to the meeting that he has reported the matter to SCC and is awaiting their response. It was stated by another member that verbal abuse from the people parking is going to lead to anti social behavior. It was requested of the Parish Clerk if he could explore the possibility of erecting signs. This subject matter is to be an agenda item for the meeting in January 2017.

#### **To discuss and set out the figures of the forthcoming Precept for 2017/2018**

Cllr Angie Sewell explained the breakdown of the Precept figures. Cllr Sewell referred to the budget and compared it with previous years. It was explained to the public that £87,000 was required from the Precept with £5,000 being provided by the Parish Council from reserves.

Open spaces allowances are now to include the salaries of the Parish Keepers. A question was asked by Cllr Lance Stanbury in respect of risk analysis, have the Parish Council considered carrying it out. Cllr Stanbury also asked if any other funding needs were required.

Cllr Sewell replied that all other eventualities were covered by reserves or S106 requests.

The general public were satisfied with the proposed Precept figures, so the necessary paperwork was signed by the Chair (Cllr Angie Sewell).

Cllr Lance Stanbury reported to the meeting that in future only one Cllr will attend Parish Council Meetings. He also reported that on the subject of devolution it required a unanimous vote.
